Letter from the Ministry Team

A few weeks ago, while in Brighton spending the day with two of my grandchildren, my six year old grandson, Rory, wanted to make cakes so while my two year old granddaughter, Cerys, was taking her afternoon nap, we made the cakes and decided to decorate them with his sister when she woke up. Coloured sprinkles at the ready, we made up some butter icing to top the cakes.

Later that afternoon, sat around the kitchen table, everything set to decorate, I spread some icing on the first cake and handed it to Cerys who dipped it into the sprinkles, she handed it back to me to put on a plate. I gave her a second cake, again she dipped it and handed it back. The third time, she looked at the cake, looked at the sprinkles, looked back at the cake - and yes, you've guessed it! Quite intentionally into her mouth it went to cries from Rory of, 'The baby's eating the cake!'. The temptation was too much! Laughter broke out as Cerys tucked in.

It was a hilarious family moment but also a powerful illustration of how we all succumb to temptation on occasions. During this season of Lent we are reminded of how Jesus spent forty days in the wilderness being tempted by the devil. Fully human, just like us he must have struggled too not to give in to temptation as he became hungry and weary. Jesus chose to trust his heavenly Father, remain faithful to him and, led by the Holy Spirit came safely out the other side.

We need to have that same trust in our Saviour Jesus Christ, remaining faithful to him in times of difficulty or temptation. He will see us safely through. When Easter Sunday arrives, we'll rejoice that through his death and resurrection, we can share in the promise and hope of new life that Jesus offers should we choose to accept.

Chippenham Deanery Synod, 7th March 2019

As usual, the meeting was an "open" one, with the theme of "A Journey of Invitation". After we had dealt with items of Synod business, Rev Alice Kemp (the Diocesan Disability Advisor) introduced us to LIGHT (Living In God's Heart Together). This is a wonderful fresh expression of church for people with special needs, held at St. Peter's Church, Chippenham on the third Sunday of the month. LIGHT members and helpers then led us in an act of worship.

"A Journey of Invitation" is a resource developed by to support parishes in "making disciples" - one of the 3 priorities underpinning the Diocesan vision of "Creating

Connections". Chris Priddy (Head of Parish & External Relations) outlined how it provides a guide to the significant opportunities in the year for focused prayer, inviting others, and exploring faith. It also offers free and accessible tools to support these.

Prior to Synod, PCC's had been asked to respond to 3 questions from the Leadership Team. These were:-

- (1) What two priorities would you in your benefice/parish like to focus on over the coming year?
- (2)What are significant changes or developments in your local communities that offer opportunities or threats during 2019?
- (3) How might others across the deanery help you with these?:

The answers would be used to guide them in developing the role of the Deanery in helping and resourcing all parishes as they move forward into the new year. The varied responses from parishes were shared in small groups and also with Chris.
